GH12	Cut hair using basic techniques <i>Learn how to create a variety of basic looks for women using club cutting, freehand and scissor-over-comb techniques. Using these cutting techniques you will demonstrate that you can produce one length hair cuts for both above and below shoulder length, uniform layers and short and long graduation haircuts. You must also demonstrate that you can work on both curly and straight hair, and part of this service is to provide your client with good aftercare advice.</i>	X

Being able to identify the capability of your clients hair will allow you to choose from a range of products, tools and equipment to complete the look.
