GB6	Provide shaving services <i>Through this unit you will develop professional shaving skills as part of the barbering services, identify the condition of your client's face, skin and facial hair to determine which products, tools and techniques to use as well as provide your client with good aftercare advice. GB9	Provide face massage services <i>Through this unit you will learn the skill of effective face massage using a variety of products and massage techniques. Being able to identify the condition of your client's face and skin will determine which products and massage techniques to use. (4 credits)</i>	✓
AH35	Design and create patterns in hair <i>Through this unit you will develop the artistic skill of cutting two and three dimensional designs within a haircut. The types of patterns you will design and create will fall into the following categories: 3D pictorial, symmetrical and repetitive patterns.(5 credits)</i>	✓
