<b>G18</b>	<b>Promote additional services or products to customers</b> <i>This unit is all about your need to keep pace with new developments and to encourage your clients to take an interest in them. Clients expect more and more services or products to be offered to meet their own growing expectations. They need to be made aware of what is available from your salon to give them a greater choice.</i>	✗
<b>G22</b>	<b>Monitor procedures to safely control work operations</b> <i>Monitoring the operation of workplace health and safety procedures is the legal responsibility of all senior staff in a salon, not just that of the manager or proprietor. <b>H32</b>	<b>Contribute to the planning and implementation of promotional activities</b> <i>This unit is about working with others to plan, implement and evaluate promotional activities. <b>GH19</b>	<b>Creatively style and dress hair</b> <i>Through this unit you will develop a variety of conventional and non-conventional dressing techniques to produce innovative, fashionable, creative and personalised looks to compliment individual clients.
